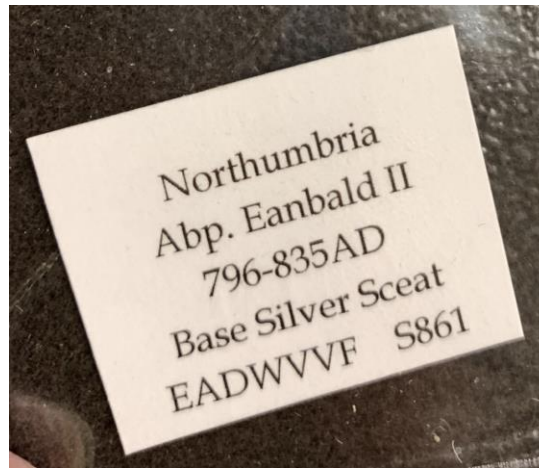
The TNA is in need of exhibitors for the 2022 TNA Coin Show educational exhibits.
