The 2025 board members are:

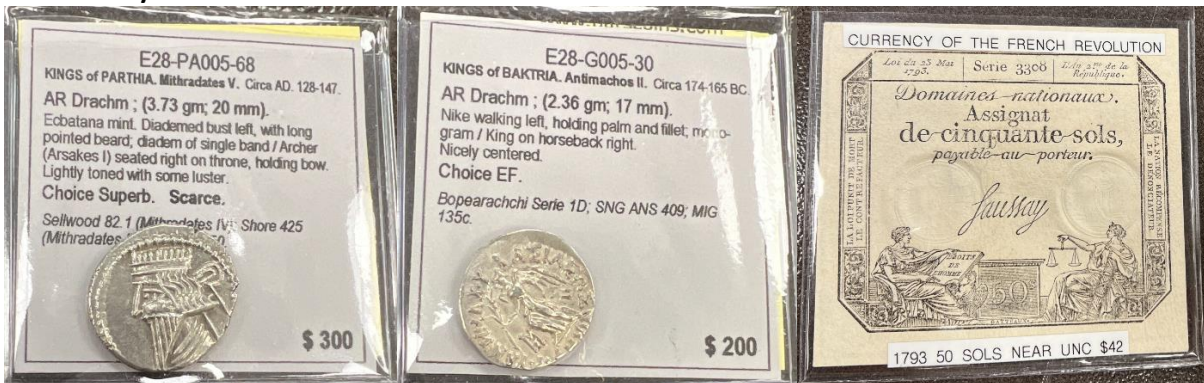

The January club meeting has been canceled due to Botanic Gardens Lightscape program. The next club meeting will be February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

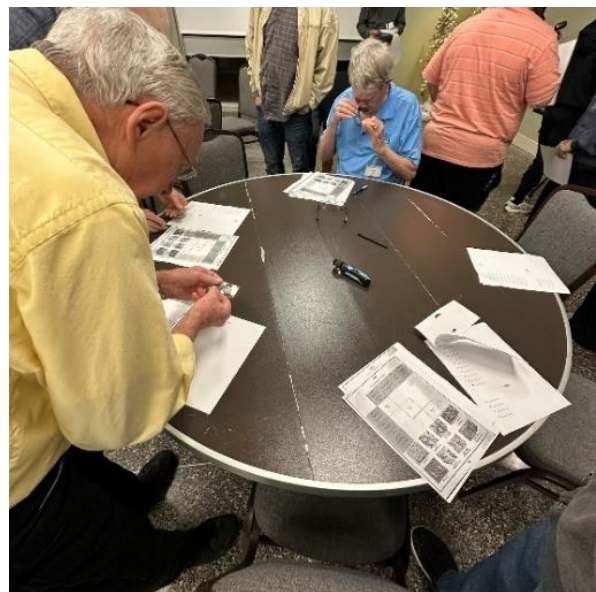
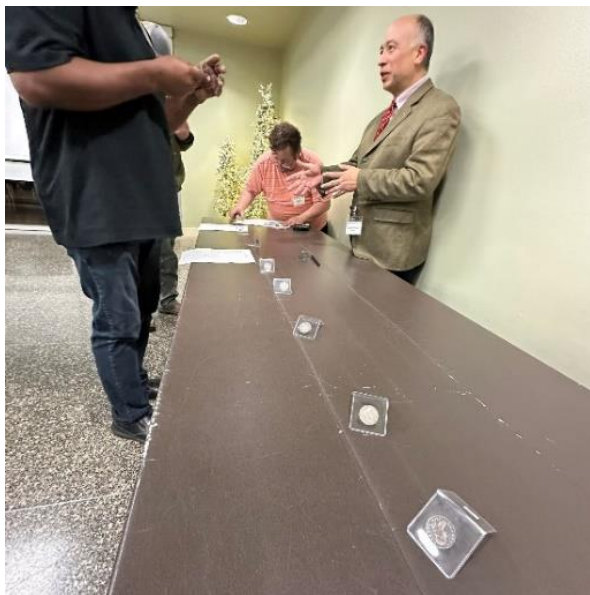
